WHAT ARE WE ABOUT

About the church Crosspoint Family Church (CPFC) which is located in Block 8, a suburb of Gaborone the capital city of Botswana. Worship at the current location began in 2017, and the church was constituted in 2014.

Beliefs and doctrine.

A Statement of Faith can be found on the church web site, www.crosspointfamilychurch.co.bw CPFC can broadly be described as a **God family orientated evangelical church**. Beliefs on some non-core doctrines may be sufficiently common among members to form a de facto church position; however CPFC does not seek uniformity of belief on such noncore matters. Importance is placed upon faithfully proclaiming God's Word, and past sermons are available online.

Attendance and demographics.

Average attendance at Sunday morning worship is currently 35-55 (COVID Regulations). Membership and attendance is normally between 85 and 115 people. We have congregants who attend via live streaming platforms during these times and remain active in church life. These include fulltime University-age students, young adults, working families, and retirees/pensioners on fixed incomes.

Music.

Congregational singing is a core element of our services. Traditional hymns and carefully-chosen contemporary Christian songs are both used during worship. Worship is led by our wonderful worship team accompanied by the piano, guitar, drums and more.

Missions and activities.

CPFC has a strong base of various ministries within the church – Ladies, Men, Youth, Kids4Jesus, Prayer and Care all of which have been active. CPFC has strong desire to grow the missions of the church and will need to be a big focus going forward. We want to work alongside, participate with and support missionaries (in Botswana and farther), CPFC wants to be encouraging CPFC members those sensing God's call to the mission field, and welcoming organisation representatives as the opportunity arises.

Association.

The church is a registered society under Botswana Law. In Botswana all churches wishing to operate are required to operate under the societies Act of Botswana and as such require a constitution and bylaws through which we operate, Any Pastor, Elder, Deacon and employee of CPFC will be required to fore fill the prescribe regulations as outlined in these documents. We are currently a member of South African Baptist union and the Baptist Northern Association. CPFC aims to maintain a good working relationship with other churches and associations, cooperating on matters of mutual interest as appropriate.

Governance.

CPFC has a congregational style of government. Church members elect (8) officers to a fixed term onto a management committee. Despite its independence, CPFC does not label itself as an "independent Baptist" church, as this can create inaccurate impressions in several areas, including the extent to which authority is vested in the pastor.
